Your chance to see the world's smallest primate, considered an endangered specie. The Tarsier has a squat body about 3 to 6 inches with a tail of about 6 inches. It has large and hairless ears and enormous round eyes with long pointed feet and round-tipped end fingers like the famous E.T. The Tarsiers are nocturnal.

TARSIER TREK: An early morning trek into the natural habitat of the oldest known primate "The Tarsier". After a 30-minute ride from the capital city of Tagbilaran, you reach Corella town; the Tarsier Sanctuary managed by the Philippine Tarsier Foundation. At the Visitor center, an expert will give briefing on the characteristics & behavior of the Tarsier and the conservation efforts of the Foundation.

Then, the trek commences. There are at least 3 different walking trails with different categories. The local ranger will accompany the trek.

Walking shoes is a must. For extra protection, put on a long-sleeved shirt and don't forget the insect repellent lotion. The trek will take about 60-90 minutes. Packed breakfast will be served.
